### Notes

All vehicles must be parked in the Tulloch Caledonian football stadium car park. There is NO parking at Black Bridge. Registration is only possible at the stadium car park except by special arrangement. Participants will be transported to the start at Black Bridge and returned to the stadium car park from the finish at Glencalvie by coach/ mini bus. Bikers must arrive at the stadium car park promptly at 7.15am. Bikes will be loaded on to separate transport to Black Bridge. Transport leaves from 8.00am. There will be transport arranged to ferry runner's kit bags to the finish line. Please make sure that all bags are clearly labeled with the owner's name.

Participants should note that they must not leave anything on the bus. Leaving litter on the route must be avoided at all costs. Bins will be provided where necessary but all participants will be expected to carry personal rubbish out with them. Follow the Scottish Countryside Access Code at all times and obey the directions given by marshals. Up to date information will be posted on the website.
